



Huntington Beach Academy for the Performing Arts Information for the 2025-2026 School Year

The Huntington Beach Academy for the Performing Arts (HB APA) is a place where talented, ambitious young performers and art lovers can extend both their academic and arts education simultaneously in an enriching atmosphere. Academy classes allow students to realize their fullest potential while interacting with peers that share their passion for the arts. Involvement in the Academy not only increases the self-esteem of its young performers, but often raises their level of academic achievement as well.

Some facts you might find interesting:

- 1. APA is a magnet program within the HBUHSD, located on the Huntington Beach High School campus. Students must attend a high school within or transfer into the Huntington Beach Union High School District.
- 2. The Academy enrolls students entering grades 9-12.
- 3. Applicants are evaluated on their academic record, auditions or interviews, as well as teacher recommendations.
- 4. APA classes are taken for Visual/Performing Arts credit or P.E credit, and are not "extra-curricular" activities. Students may not add or drop classes at their own discretion.
- 5. Students may attend any high school within HBUHSD (EHS, FVHS, HBHS, MHS, OVHS, WHS) and attend afternoon APA classes.
- 6. If a student lives outside of the HBUHSD and is accepted into the APA program, they may apply for a transfer to Huntington Beach High School (HBHS).
- 7. Students are required to take two (2) APA classes per semester for a well-rounded APA education and to fulfill the APA Honor Cord program requirements.
- 8. All APA classes fulfill Visual Performing Arts requirements for UC and CSU systems. We also DEADLINE EXTENDED, PLEASE CALL: offer several honors and dual-enrollment college classes. APA OFFICE 714-536-2514 #5145

So, your student is interested – what's next?

- 1. Complete the application for the 2025-2026 school year and submit it by the deadline: Friday, January 31st, 2025 by 3:00 p.m.
- 2. Applications may be submitted in person or mailed to the APA Office at: 1905 Main Street, Huntington Beach, CA 92648 (located in the Music Building).
- 3. Students may apply for up to two departments, and are encouraged to do so.
- 4. You will be notified of your *audition day*. See page 2 for more information.
- 5. We call you with audition appointment dates and times one to two weeks prior to auditions. We make appointments only for students who have submitted their applications by the due date.
- 6. If you are planning to transfer your student to HBHS, start the application process at your residence school now, and indicate on the transfer application: Pending APA acceptance.

Dear Applicant: We are excited that you are considering APA. Be sure to review the entire application, as it contains important information, helpful hints for audition preparation, and required paperwork. Many of your questions can be answered by the information available at hbapa.org under our *Be APA* page.

APA Audition Requirements

To audition or interview for APA, you must ensure that you have submitted the complete APA application to the APA office FRIDAY, JAN 31, 2025. The complete APA application includes:

Below are the APA audition requirements, listed by department. Please read through the guidelines for the department(s) you are auditioning or interviewing for. The APA Office will arrange the audition or interview time with applicants based upon Diretor availability. The APA office will notify you a week before auditions of your specific audition date and time. We must receive a call back to confirm your students audition. *We wish you the very best of luck!*

DEPARTMENT	AUDITION REQUIREMENTS
Acting	 Perform 2 one-minute memorized monologues: 1 comedy and 1 drama It is advisable that one monologue is a character close to you in terms of age and personality. The other monologue should show your range in terms of playing a challenging character. Monologues should be from published plays. Introduce each monologue by the name of the play, the author, & the character you are performing (Monologues from plays/scripts can be found on the internet or at your local library)
Costume Design	Interview with Costume Design faculty and presentation of portfolio or samples, if available. Please be prepared to answer this question: <i>"Why do you want to be a member of the</i> <i>APA Costume Design department?"</i>
Dance	 Learn a ballet barre, jazz progression, modern combination, & tap sequence on site. Prior technical training <i>required</i> Attire: dark leotard, pink or black tights, hair back. Bring jazz shoes & ballet slippers. tap shoes optional
Dramatic Production Playwriting & Directing	Presentation of a portfolio, if available. Playwrights: Bring writing samples of plays, short stories, poems, etc. Directors: Expect a short interview in which you will talk about your leadership potential and creative ideas
Musical Theatre	 This department calls for a live audition as well as a video vocal audition due on FRIDAY. JAN 31, 2025 by 3:00 PM. 1. Submit your vocal audition video: Submit a video of 32 bars of an up-tempo Broadway Standard or contemporary up-tempo Broadway song <u>AND</u> 16 bars of a Broadway Standard Ballad or contemporary Broadway Ballad. Submissions may be with a track or with an accompanist. Videos must be uploaded to a platform such as YouTube or Vimeo. Email video links to <u>apamtdept@gmail.com</u> by FRIDAY, JAN 31, 2025 Subject line should read: <u>MT Audition Jane Doe</u> 2. Live auditions, consisting of three components: SING: Perform 32 bars of an up-tempo Broadway Standard and 16 bars of a contemporary Broadway Ballad (song selections may be the same as your audition video). Please bring your sheet music in the correct key. On audition day, you may be asked to perform only a portion of your music, but be prepared to perform the entire selection if asked. DANCE: Learn and perform a short dance combination on-site at auditions ACT: Perform one (1) memorized monologue from a Broadway musical. Introduce the monologue by the name of the musical and the character you are performing.

DEPARTMENT	AUDITION REQUIREMENTS
MMET: Media	 All students will be interviewed by Mr. Rhone and are to produce and submit a video about themselves not to exceed 3 minutes (maximum). Make a 3-minute film that demonstrates your creativity, style, and skills in filmmaking. Videos should be uploaded to a platform such as YouTube or Google Drive. Once uploaded, please copy the link and visit <u>hbapa.online/MEDIA-AUDITION-VIDEO</u> to upload your video's link by FRIDAY, JAN 31, 2025.
MMET: Popular Music	 VOCALISTS: Be prepared to sing one (1) pop or rock song of your choice. Please bring your own accompaniment (such as a karaoke track in your preferred key). You will not be permitted to sing acapella or to the original track with vocals. Please visit <u>bit.ly/MMETaudition</u> Perform one (1) entire song from the list provided in the folder. Materials will be posted in this folder January 1. INSTRUMENTALISTS: Bring your guitar or bass. You do not need to bring a keybeard, drum set, pedal boards, or amps (these are provided). Know how to plug into an amp and tune your instrument. Be prepared to perform one (1) popular rock or pop song of your choice. Please play a verse and a chorus. If you have a recording to play along with, you may do so. Please visit bit.ly/MMETaudition Perform 1 song from the list provided in the folder. Materials will be posted in this folder January 1. Be prepared to play a twelve-bar blues progression in the key of A.
Orchestra Traditional Music Program	 Play 1-2 short selections (3-minutes maximum) which best demonstrate your musical and technical ability. Expect a short excerpt to sight-read. Play scales from memory as follows (two octaves when possible): <u>Wind instruments</u>: B-flat, E-flat, A-flat, F, C, chromatic (from your lowest note to highest note - show your range) <u>String instruments</u>: C, G, D, A, F, chromatic (from your lowest note to highest note show your range) <u>Piano</u>: F, C, G (2 hands), 2 octave chromatic C-C <u>Guitar, drum set</u>: demonstrate the following styles - swing, rock, Latin <u>Concert percussion</u> (in addition to 1-2 short selections: keyboard marimba, bells, etc.): C, B-flat, E-flat scales, concert snare drum-roll soft to loud to soft. Bring your instrument & sheet music. A piano, all percussion, & guitar amp are available.
Technical Theatre	 All students will be interviewed by Technical Theatre faculty, and may prepare the following: 1. Not required, however applicants are highly encouraged to bring samples in the areas of Technical Theatre which might include photos of their lighting design project(s), sound design, set design, painting, construction, stage management, etc Other items to bring to the interview might be samples of sketches, drawings, or photos of art pieces (including sculpture or paintings) created by the applicant. 2. Speak on your supporting abilities for Technical Theatre (such as skills in drawing, painting, carpentry, craftsmanship, technical skills, or other hobbies/occupational interests). 3. Please be prepared to answer questions regarding Technical Theatre, such as why you are interested in the department, what experience you have, moments you have prioritized safety and communication, and an achievement you are most proud of. 4. You are welcome to ask Mr. Behrens and Mr. Henderson any questions you may have about the program and department.

What to Do Now

- <u>Request your Instructor Recommendation Form (page 13).</u> Please submit this form to your chosen instructor early, as it may take time. If you need an electronic copy of the Instructor Recommendation Form to email to your teacher, download a copy at <u>hbapa.online/instructor-recommendation</u> Once completed, the instructor may either: a) email the completed form to <u>asharp@hbuhsd.edu</u>
 b) give it back to you in a signed and sealed envelope, or c) mail the completed form to HB APA: 1905 Main St, Huntington Beach, CA 92648.
- 3. Thoroughly read through the audition guidelines for each department.
- 4. Start preparing for your audition.

Application Procedure



- Follow all instructions carefully and submit the completed application to the APA office by Friday, FRIDAY, JAN 31, 2025 at 3pm.
- 2. Incomplete applications delay the process and may not be accepted.
- **3.** Please reserve the entire day for your audition.
- **4.** After submitting your APA Application, you will receive a phone call with your appointment time and other details for your auditions about 1-2 weeks before the audition day. You must respond to be placed on the audition/interview list.
- 5. Please check your calendar to make sure that there is not a conflict.
- **6.** You may audition for up to two APA departments. Please indicate your 1st and 2nd choice on your application.
- 7. If you are auditioning for MMET: Media or Musical Theatre, submit your video by

FRIDAY, JAN 31, 2025 (this is the same day that applications are due).

On Audition Day

- **1.** Please dress appropriately for your audition and/or interview.
- 2. Arrive 30 minutes before your appointment time.
- **3.** Be prepared. Those who are not prepared (not to be confused with those who are nervous) will not be considered for acceptance.
- 4. Break a leg!
